Water Safety Update, September 1, 2010

The Provincetown Swim for Life & Paddler Flotilla would like to assure participants that swimmer and kayaker safety will continue to be the event's top priority. In response to great white shark sightings off Cape Cod, [an additional pre-caution is being taken this year.](#)

On the morning of the event, two marine biologists with Provincetown Center for Coastal Studies will sweep the harbor for shark sightings aboard the research vessel *Ibis*. The US Coast Guard and the Provincetown Harbormaster will also have vessels in the harbor to assist in water safety.

The USCG reports no shark sightings in Provincetown Harbor.
